



Naming User kits on the DTXIIS

Once you have programmed a User Kit in the DTXIIS you will want to give it a name. You can name it for the song it will be used on or you can use it to reference a particular gig you will use it on. This "Jump Start" will show you how to name your User Kits. **The knobs are numbered 1-5, left to right.**

NOTE: To scroll quickly through the letters of the alphabet hold down the SHIFT button as you turn the knob. This will scroll through the alphabet ten letters at a time with each click instead of one at a time.

1. Press the button that says **TRIGGER**.
2. Press and hold the **PAGE DOWN** button until the screen stops scrolling. The screen will read KIT NAME. If you are re-voicing a factory kit, the name of that kit will show on the screen. If you started with a User Kit the screen will read User Kit.
3. The first letter will be underlined by the cursor. You can move the cursor to the left or right by turning #2 clockwise or counterclockwise. Move the cursor under the first letter you want to change
4. Turn the knob until the letter or symbol you want shows above the cursor. You can select upper or lower case letters, numbers, or symbols. To insert a blank space turn knob #3 counter clockwise until the space appears.
5. Move the cursor under the next letter you want to change and select the next figure you want and repeat the process until you have named the kit.
6. Press the **STORE** button. The screen will read Store Current Drumkit to kit U_, and the green light below the button will flash.
7. Turn knob #4 to select which user kit you want this stored in.
8. Press the **ENTER/YES** button. The screen will read Are You Sure? [YES/NO].
9. Press the **ENTER/YES** button one more time. The screen will read Done.
10. The module will automatically switch to **PLAY** mode and the User Kit you named will be selected.
